We have designed a new hybrid classroom to reach the many students in our refugee/immigrant classes (some wanting to join from other states), literacy classes, and hopefully for the inmates in prisons needing programming, care, and hope. We also hope to start training professionals in health, human services, education, and employment and other arenas to learn some ASL and get tools to provide services to Deaf and hard of hearing consumers who show up at their doors. Although we were denied three proposals to establish transitional housing for Deaf/HH who are homeless, leaving prison, domestic violence survivors or impacted by situations out of their control, we have housed several individuals and will not give up!
